The Government Operations Committee reports a favorable recommendation on S.B. 204, CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT PROCESS APPROVAL REQUIREMENTS AMENDMENTS, by Senator J. S. Adams, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1. Page 2, Line 56 through Page 3, Line 60:
 - 56 (3) (a) Except as provided in Subsections (3)(b), (d), and (e), a capital development
 - 57 project may not be constructed on state property without legislative approval.
 - (b) Legislative approval is not required for a capital development project that consists of the design or construction of a new facility if the State
 - 59 Building Board determines that:
 - 60 (i) the requesting [higher education] state agency, commission, department, or
- 2. Page 3, Line 76 through Page 4, Line 90:
 - 76 (d) Legislative approval is not required for:
 - 77 (i) the renovation, remodeling, or retrofitting of an existing facility with nonstate
 - 78 funds[;] {-, except that legislative approval is required unless the State Building

 - 79 <u>determination that legislative approval is not required in accordance with Subsection</u>
 (3)(b) for

 - 82 <u>(B) so substantial that a facility would not be suitable for occupancy or use by a state</u>
