Mr. President:

The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 279**, GRAND JURY MODIFICATIONS, by Senator M. Dayton, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 15:
 - requires a grand jury subpoena to be issued to a:
 <u>minor, who is a</u> victim of crime <u></u> at least 72 hours before the victim is required to testify; and
 witness to testify at least 48 hours before the witness is required to
 - 15 {• witness to testify at least 48 hours before the witness is required to testify; and }
- 2. Page 2, Lines 44 through 47:
 - 44 {<u>(i)</u>} <u>(c)</u> <u>A subpoena requiring a</u> <u>minor, who is a</u> <u>victim of a crime</u> <u>,</u> to testify before a grand jury may not be
 - 45 served less than 72 hours before the victim is required to testify.
