H.B. 308 Parental Waivers of Liability on Behalf of Minors (*Rep. K. Powell*)

The motion failed with Rep. Cox voting in favor.

The original motion to pass the bill favorably passed with Rep. Biskupski, Rep. King, Rep. Wheatley, Rep. Wilson, and Rep. Gibson voting in opposition. Rep. Cox and Rep. Hutchings were absent for the vote.

H.B. 267 Public Body Rules of Procedure (*Rep. M. Brown*)

MOTION: Rep. Biskupski moved to pass 1st Substitute H.B. 267 with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Cox and Rep. Hutchings absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Biskupski moved to place 1st Substitute H.B. 267 on the Consent Calendar. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Cox and Rep. Hutchings absent for the vote.

H.B. 324 **HIV Testing of Alleged Sex Offenders** (*Rep. R. Greenwood*)

H.B. 349 **Expedited Jury Trials** (*Rep. B. King*)

Rep. King presented the bill to the committee.
