# S.B. 14 Local Election Amendments (Sen. P. Knudson) (Rep. D. Sagers)

Sen. Knudson introduced the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Wiley moved to amend the bill as follows:

- 1. Page 22, Lines 669 through 673:
  - 669 (1) (a) Each person wishing to become a valid write-in candidate shall file a declaration
  - 670 of candidacy in person or through a designated agent for a candidate for President or Vice
  - 671 President of the United States with the appropriate filing officer not later than 30 days before
  - 672 the regular general election or <u>45 days before a</u> municipal general election in which the person intends to be a
  - 673 write-in candidate.

The motion to amend the bill passed unanimously with Rep. Dunnigan, Rep. Morley, Rep. Sandstrom, and Rep. Webb absent for the vote.
