## H.B. 268 Municipal Enforcement Regarding Property Maintenance (*Rep. M. Morley*)

Rep. Morley introduced the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Webb moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, Lines 37 through 42:

- 37 (1) designate[<del>,</del>] and regulate the abatement of[<del>, injurious and noxious weeds, garbage,</del>
- 38 refuse, or any unsightly or deleterious objects or structures, and may]:
- 39 (a) { the growth and spread of injurious and noxious } weeds;
- 40 (b) garbage and refuse;
- 41 (c) {<u>unsightly or deleterious objects</u>} <u>a public nuisance</u>; or

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42 (d) {<u>unsightly or deleterious structures</u>} <u>an illegal object or structure</u>; and

- 2. Page 2, Lines 49 through 54:
  - 49 (i) may, subject to Subsection (1)(b), direct the inspector to examine and investigate
  - 50 <u>real property for:</u>
  - 51 (A) { the growth and spread of injurious and noxious } weeds;
  - 52 (B) garbage and refuse;
  - 53 (C) {<u>unsightly or deleterious objects</u>} <u>a public nuisance</u> ; or
  - 54 (D) {<u>unsightly or deleterious structures</u>} <u>an illegal object or structure</u> ; and

The motion to amend the bill passed unanimously with Rep. Anderson, Rep. Dunnigan, and Rep. Pitcher absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Webb moved to amend the bill as follows:

- 1. Page 4, Line 118 through Page 5, Line 121:
  - 118 (ii) notify the property owner:
  - 119 (A) that failure to pay the expenses described in Subsection (1)(b)(i)(B) may result in a
  - 120 <u>lien on the property</u> { <u>on a parity with and collectible at the same time and in the same</u> manner as
  - **121 <u>general property taxes</u> )** <u>in accordance with Section 10-11-4;</u>
- 2. Page 7, Lines 184 through 192:
  - 184 (2) Subject to Subsection (3), the unpaid costs and expenses, upon their certification
  - 185 <u>under Subsection (1)</u>  $\{ -, \}$ 
    - (a) become a lien on the property { on a parity with and collectible at the same
  - 186 <u>time and in the same manner as general property taxes that are a lien on the</u> <u>property.</u> } <u>; and</u>

## (b) have the force and effect of a valid judgment of the district court.

- 187 (3) If the county treasurer is unable to include the costs and expenses in the tax notice
- 188 for the year in which they are incurred by a municipality, the costs and expenses shall:
- 189 (a) be carried over to the tax notice for the following year; and
- 190 (b) become a lien { on the property on a parity with and collectible at the same

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## time and

- 191 <u>in the same manner as general property taxes that are a lien on the property for the year</u>

   described in Subsection (3)(a).
   described in Subsection (2).
