Representative **Stephen E. Sandstrom** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 41 through 46:
 - 41 (v) <u>subject to Subsection (3)</u>, in the reasonable belief of the innkeeper, bringing [in] <u>onto the</u> accommodations
 - property that may be dangerous to other persons[-]:
 - 43 (A) including [firearms or explosives;] an explosive; and
 - 44 (B) except that an innkeeper may refuse or deny accommodations, facilities, or
 - 45 privileges to a person for bringing a firearm onto the accommodations, only for the unlawful
 - 46 possession or unlawful use of the firearm;
- 2. *Page 3, Lines 85 through 86:*
 - 85 establishment's facilities or privileges based upon the person's race, creed, color, national
 - 86 origin, gender, disability, or marital status.

(3)(a) If a person brings a firearm onto the accommodations of a lodging establishment, the innkeeper of the lodging establishment is not criminally or civilly liable for any injury, damage to property, or loss that results from the person bringing a firearm onto the accommodations of the lodging establishment.

(b) Subsection (3)(a) does not apply if the innkeeper solicits, requests, commands, encourages, or intentionally aids the person with a firearm in discharging the firearm while on the lodging establishment.
