Representative **Eric K. Hutchings** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 47 through 50:
 - 47 (2) In approving an increase in { charter school } _ the enrollment capacity of existing charter school , the State Board of
 - 48 Education shall give preference to an application for expansion submitted by :
 - (a) a high performing
 - 49 <u>charter school, as evidenced by the charter school's proficiency and progress scores on the</u>
 - 50 <u>school's U-PASS accountability report</u> { : or
 - (b) a charter school that has substantially higher levels of student achievement compared to schools with similar demographics.
 - (3)(a) The State Charter School Board shall submit recommendations to the State Board of Education for the expansion of the enrollment capacity of existing charter schools.
 - (b) A charter school expansion that is not approved by the State Board of Education shall be considered to be tentatively approved for the next application year.
- 2. Page 2, Line 57:
 - 57 <u>that has received a letter grade of A on the school grading system</u> <u>or has substantially higher levels of</u>
 <u>student achievement compared to schools with similar demographics</u> ."
