 - in or about a courthouse or courtroom or a secure area in the courthouse; {-and--}
 - provides that court personnel may not take or remove the peace officer's firearm
 - while the officer is acting within the officer's scope of authority {-} : and provides for an exception.
- 2. Page 2, Line 49:
 - 49 (4) {—A—} (a) Except as otherwise provided in Subsection (4)(b), a peace officer, while acting within the scope of authority as a peace officer, is
- 3. Page 2, Line 52:
 - 52 secure area, and acting within the officer's scope of authority.
 - (b) A responsible law enforcement agency of the court, such as a sheriff's office, may make rules regarding the transporting of a prisoner from one holding cell to another within a court facility in which the peace officer transporting the prisoner is not to carry a firearm.
