# HIGHER EDUCATION RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

Senator **Margaret Dayton** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Line 78 through Page 4, Line 96:*

- 78           (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (3), an institution within the state system of higher  
79 education shall grant resident student status for tuition purposes to a child of a United States  
80 military person assigned to active duty if :
- (i) the child is:
- (A) 26 years old or younger; and  
          (B) unmarried; and  
          (ii) the child produces:
- 81           ~~(i)~~   (A) one of the following:  
82           ~~(A)~~   (I) the military parent's United States active duty military identification card;  
83           ~~(B)~~   (II) the child's United States active duty military identification and privilege card; or  
84           ~~(C)~~   (III) a statement from the military parent's current company commander stating that the  
85 military parent is on active duty; and
- 86           ~~(ii)~~   (B) one of the following:  
87           ~~(A)~~   (I) the military parent's state of legal residence certificate with Utah listed as the  
88 military parent's home of record;
- 89           ~~(B)~~   (II) the military parent's Utah driver license;  
90           ~~(C)~~   (III) the military parent's Utah voter registration card;  
91           ~~(D)~~   (IV) a mortgage statement for a Utah residence listing the military parent's name and  
92 Utah address;
- 93           ~~(E)~~   (V) a current Utah vehicle registration document with the military parent's name as  
94 owner of the vehicle; or
- 95           ~~(F)~~   (VI) the military parent's leave and earnings statement showing Utah as the state where  
96 income taxes are paid.
