

# S.B. 48

## ALZHEIMER'S STATE PLAN TASK FORCE

Senator **Karen W. Morgan** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 28 through 32:*

28 This bill appropriates:

29 ▶ \$2,040, as a one-time ~~{,nonlapsing}~~ appropriation, to the House;

30 ▶ \$2,040, as a one-time ~~{,nonlapsing}~~ appropriation, to the Senate; and

31 ▶ \$20,920, as a one-time, nonlapsing appropriation, to the Division of Aging and

32 Adult Services , subject to intent language stating that the \$20,920 shall be used, first for the expenses of the Alzheimer's State Plan Task Force, with the remaining money to be used by the Division of Aging and Adult Services to fund respite care for individuals with Alzheimer's disease or related dementia .

2. *Page 3, Lines 81 through 84:*

81 (xii) two representatives of one or more organizations that provide volunteer services

82 relating to the care and support of a person with Alzheimer's disease ~~{,with priority being given~~

83 to an organization that donates more than \$20,000 to the Alzheimer's State Plan Task Force

84 Restricted Account }

3. *Page 6, Lines 154 through 156:*

154 ~~{(5) Funds left in the account after paying the obligations under Subsection (4) shall be~~

155 used by the department to fund respite care for individuals with Alzheimer's disease or related

156 dementia.}

4. *Page 6, Lines 157 through 179:*

157 Section 7. Appropriation.

158 Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures Act, the

159 following sums of money are appropriated from resources not otherwise appropriated out of the funds or  
160 accounts indicated for the fiscal

161 year beginning July 1, 2010, and ending June 30, 2011. These appropriations are in addition to

162 the amounts previously appropriated for fiscal year 2011.
