- 1. Page 4, Lines 91 through 94:
 - 91 (i) for property exempt under Subsection (2)(a)(i), the maximum exemption may not
 - 92 exceed $\{+\}$ \$10,000 $\{+\}$ $\{\frac{\$100,000}{,000}\}$ per household; or
 - 93 (ii) for property exempt under Subsection (2)(a)(ii), the maximum exemption may not
 - 94 exceed {-\$40,000} <u>\$100,000</u> per household.
- 2. Page 4, Lines 109 through 111:
 - (b) If a property is sold at a sheriff's sale, the homestead claim amount shall be paid by
 - the judgement creditor in cash , by cashier's check or other certified funds to the sheriff at or before the time of sale for immediate
 - transmittal by the sheriff to the individual entitled to the exemption.
