

S.B. 209
TELECOMMUNICATIONS AMENDMENTS

Senator **Curtis S. Bramble** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 9 through 17:*

- 9 This bill provides that the existing surcharge on residential and business lines, for the
10 provision of telecommunications devices to hearing and speech impaired persons, shall
11 apply to ~~{residential, business, and mobile telephone numbers}~~ each access line for residential and
business telephone service and each telephone number for mobile telephone service .
12 Highlighted Provisions:
13 This bill:
14 ▶ provides that the existing surcharge on residential and business lines, for the
15 provision of telecommunications devices to hearing and speech impaired persons,
16 shall apply to ~~{residential, business, and mobile telephone numbers}~~ each access line for residential
and business telephone service and each telephone number for mobile telephone service ;
17 ▶ reduces the maximum surcharge from 25 cents to 20 cents; and

2. *Page 3, Lines 65 through 75:*

- 65 (4) (a) The commission shall impose a surcharge on each ~~{residence and business
66 access line of each customer to the local exchange of any telephone corporation providing such
67 lines in this state} telephone number of each residential and business customer in this
state}~~ residential and business access line of each customer of local-exchange telephone service in this
state, and each residential and business telephone number of each customer of mobile telephone service in
this state .
68 which shall be collected by the telecommunications corporation providing public
69 telecommunications service to the customer, to cover the costs of:
70 (i) the program described in Subsection (2); and
71 (ii) payments made under Subsection (5).
72 (b) The commission shall establish by rule the amount to be charged under this section,
73 [which may] provided that:
74 (i) the surcharge does not exceed [25] 20 cents per [residence] month for each
75 residential and business {access line} telephone number} access line for local-exchange telephone
service, and for each residential and business telephone number for mobile telephone service ; and
