ENACTS UNCODIFIED MATERIAL

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*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. **Repeal of H.B. 477.**

This bill repeals H.B. 477, Laws of Utah 2011, Chapter 16.

Section 2. **Effective date.**

If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this bill takes effect upon approval by the governor, or the day following the constitutional time limit of Utah Constitution Article VII, Section 8, without the governor's signature, or in the case of a veto,

28a **§→ Section 3. Legislative Intent**

28b **(1) The Legislature intends and requests that the governor convene the Legislature into a**  
28c **special session no later than June 24, 2011, to consider changes to government records**  
28d **provisions.**

28e **(2) The Legislature intends and requests that:**

28f **(a) the Legislature refer government records issues to one or more interim committees**  
28g **for review; and**

28h **(b) those interim committees hold at least two meetings, both of which include**  
28i **opportunities for public comment.** ←§
