LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies Title 62A, Chapter 4a, Child and Family Services by requiring the Division of Child and Family Services to post the name of a private service provider on the division's website.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **62A-4a-106** is amended to read:

62A-4a-106. Services provided by division.



28 (1) The division may provide, directly or through contract, services that include the
29 following:

- 30 (a) adoptions;
- 31 (b) day care for children;
- 32 (c) out-of-home placements for minors;
- 33 (d) health-related services;
- 34 (e) homemaking services;
- 35 (f) home management services;
- 36 (g) protective services for minors;
- 37 (h) transportation services; and
- 38 (i) domestic violence services.

39 (2) Services provided directly by the division or through contract shall be monitored by
40 the division to insure compliance with applicable:

- 41 (a) state law; and
- 42 (b) standards and rules of the division.

43 (3) When the division provides a service through a private contract, ~~H~~→ not including a
