regular school day.		
(b) An elementary school or elementary school teacher may compile and provide to a		
student's parent or guardian a suggested list of supplies for use during the regular school day se	0	
that a parent or guardian may furnish on a voluntary basis those supplies for student use.		
(c) A list provided to a student's parent or guardian pursuant to Subsection (2)(b) must	<u>t</u>	
include and be preceded by the following language:		
"NOTICE: THE ITEMS ON THIS LIST WILL BE USED DURING THE REGULAR		
SCHOOL DAY. THEY MAY BE BROUGHT FROM HOME ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS.	1	
OTHERWISE, THEY WILL BE FURNISHED BY THE SCHOOL."
