(	1) The county clerk may not remove a voter's name from the official register because



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28	the voter has failed to vote in an election.
29	(2) The county clerk may remove a voter's name from the official register only when:
30	(a) the voter dies and the requirements of Subsection (3) are met;
31	(b) the county clerk, after complying with the requirements of Section 20A-2-306,
32	receives written confirmation from the voter that the voter no longer resides within the county
33	clerk's county;
34	(c) the county clerk has obtained evidence that the voter's residence has changed, has
