31A-22-640. Cancellation of health benefit plan due to incarceration.
(1) Except as permitted by Subsection (2), an insurer offering a health benefit plan
under this chapter or Chapter 8, Health Maintenance Organizations and Limited Health Plans,
may not cancel an individual's coverage under a health benefit plan while the individual is
incarcerated and waiting on the disposition of the criminal charges against the individual.
(2) Subsection (1) does not prohibit an insurer from cancelling an individual's coverage
under a health benefit plan for reasons other than the incarceration of the individual pending
disposition of charges, if the reason for cancellation is provided for in the health benefit plan
contract.
