33	Section 1. Section 73-18-15 is amended to read:
34	73-18-15. Board to adopt rules concerning water skiing and aquaplane riding

36	The board shall adopt rules for the regulation and safety of water skiing and aquaplane
37	riding, and the use of other devices [which] that are towed behind a vessel pursuant to this

40	73-18-16. Regattas, races, exhibitions Rules.
41	(1) The division may authorize the holding of regattas, motorboat or other boat races,
