8 **General Description:**

9 This bill enacts language related to the computation of time in statutory construction.

23 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

24 Section 1. Section **68-3-7** is amended to read:

25 **68-3-7. Time, how computed.**

26 ~~[The]~~ (1) A person shall compute the period of time ~~[in which any act]~~ provided by law
27 ~~[is to be done is computed]~~ to perform an act by:

28 (a) excluding the first day; and

29 (b) except as provided in Subsection (2), including the last~~[, unless]~~ day.

30 (2) If the last day is [a holiday, and then it also is excluded.] a legal holiday, a
31 Saturday, or a Sunday, then a person shall:

32 (a) exclude the day described in this Subsection (2) from the time computation
33 described in Subsection (1); and

34 (b) compute the period of time to include the end of the next day that is not a legal
35 holiday, a Saturday, or a Sunday.

36 Section 2. Section **68-3-8** is amended to read:

37 **68-3-8. When a day appointed is a holiday.**

38 Whenever any act of a secular nature, other than a work of necessity or mercy, is
39 appointed by law or contract to be performed upon a particular day, which day falls upon a
40 legal holiday, such act may be performed upon the next succeeding business day with the same
41 effect as if it had been performed upon the day appointed.
