19	WHEREAS, the Legislature acting under the authority of Section 36-2-2, Utah Code
20	Annotated 1953, is required to set the compensation of its in-session employees by joint
21	resolution:
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the state of Utah that
23	the compensation of legislative in-session employees for actual hours worked be set as follows:
24	Employees shall be paid the hourly rate as specified in this resolution.
25	Employees who are working for the Legislature for the first time shall be paid under the
26	"Level 1" scale.
27	Employees who are working their second annual general session shall be paid under the



28 "Level 2" scale.

Employees who are working their third annual general session shall be paid under the "Level 3" scale.

Employees who are working their fourth annual general session shall be paid under the "Level 4" scale.

Employees who are working their fifth to ninth annual general session shall be paid under the "Level 5" scale.

Employees who are working their 10th to 14th annual general session shall be paid under the "Level 6" scale.

Employees who are working their 15th to 19th annual general session shall be paid under the "Level 7" scale.

Employees who are working their 20th or more annual general session shall be paid under the "Level 8" scale.

Senate employees are designated with an "S." House of Representative employees are designated with an "H."
