Mr. President:

The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 99**, BACKGROUND CHECK FEE EXEMPTION FOR FIREARM PURCHASE, by Representative B. Galvez, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 16:
 - This bill:
 - 14 allows a law enforcement officer currently employed and in good standing to
 - purchase a firearm without paying the requisite background check fee as long as the
 - dealer verifies the officer's employment and standing with the employing agency; and
 - <u>requires a dealer who provides a firearm to a law enforcement officer to use</u>

 the NCIS system to run the background check
- 2. Page 4, Lines 105 through 108
