Madam Speaker:

The Judiciary Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 116**, PROBATE CODE AMENDMENTS, by Representative V. L. Snow, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 10, Lines 290 through 298:*

290 ~~{(2) An order adjudicating incapacity may specify a minimum period, not~~
 ~~exceeding one~~
291 ~~year, during which no petition for an adjudication that the protected person is no~~
 ~~longer~~
292 ~~incapacitated may be filed without special leave. Subject to this restriction, the~~
