The Transportation and Public Utilities and Technology Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 266**, DRIVER EDUCATION AMENDMENTS, by Representative B. Daw, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 13 through 19*

*House Committee Amendments*

*1-27-2012:*

- 13           ▶ provides that the Driver License Division may not license a person who is
