Madam Speaker:

The Business and Labor Committee recommends **H.B. 362**, FOOD HANDLER TRAINING AMENDMENTS, by Representative J. Anderson, be replaced with **2nd Sub. H.B. 362**, FOOD HANDLER TRAINING AMENDMENTS, with the following amendments, and has returned it to the Rules Committee without recommendation.

Page 2, Lines 33 through 38

- 33 (1) As used in this section:
34 (a) "Approved training provider" means an entity:
35 (i) using a training program accredited by the American National Standards
 Institute under ANSI ASTM
36 International E2659-09 Standard Practice for Certificate Programs; {and} or
37 (ii) approved by the department under Subsection (7) to provide a food handler
 training
38 certificate course and test.

Page 3, Lines 61 through 65

- 61 (5) (a) A person serving as a food handler for a food service establishment shall
 obtain
62 a food handler permit:
63 (i) within 30 days of initial employment with a food service establishment or prior
 to handling any food ;
64 (ii) immediately upon expiration of the person's food handler permit; and
65 (iii) every three years thereafter.
