Madam Speaker:

The Public Utilities and Technology Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 421**, LOCAL DISTRICT DISSOLUTION, by Representative D. McCay, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1. Page 5, Lines 136 through 141:
 - 136 (9) A local district may not be created under this chapter for two years after the date on
 - 137 which {a} an inactive local district is dissolved in accordance with Part 13,

 Dissolution of a Local District, if
 - the local district proposed for creation:
 - (a) provides the same or substantially similar services as the dissolved inactive local district;
 - 140 and
 - 141 (b) is located in substantially the same area as the dissolved inactive local district.
- 2. Page 5, Line 146 through Page 6, Line 156:
 - 146 (2) "Administrative body" means:
 - (a) if the local district proposed to be dissolved <u>is active and</u> has a duly constituted
 - board of trustees in sufficient numbers to form a quorum, the board of trustees; {-or-}
 - 149 (b) { except as provided in Subsection (2)(a): } if the local district proposed to be dissolved is active or inactive and does not have a duly constituted board of trustees in sufficient numbers to form a quorum:
 - 150 (i) for a local district located entirely within a single municipality, the legislative body
 - of that municipality;
 - (ii) for a local district located in multiple municipalities within the same county or at
 - least partly within the unincorporated area of a county, the legislative body of that county; or
 - (iii) for a local district located within multiple counties, the legislative body of the







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county whose boundaries include more of the local district than is included within the

boundaries of any other county {-}

(c) if the local district proposed to be dissolved is inactive and has a duly constituted board of trustees in sufficient numbers to form a quorum:

(i) the board of trustees, if the board of trustees receives a petition or adopts a resolution to dissolve before the legislative body described in Subsection (2)(c)(ii); or

(ii) a legislative body described in Subsection (2)(b)(i), (ii), or (iii), respectively, if the legislative body receives a petition or adopts a resolution to dissolve before the board of trustees described in Subsection (2)(c)(i).
