## **H.B. 109** Use of Controlled Substances in Research (Rep. D. Sanpei)

  - 305 research may produce, possess, {-or} administer, {-but may not} prescribe \_\_\_ or dispense {-,} a controlled
  - 306 substance <u>for research purposes as licensed under Subsection (2) but may not</u> otherwise prescribe or dispense a controlled substance listed in Section 58-37-4.2.
