Vice Chair Sandstrom called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m.

MOTION: Rep. Galvez made a motion to approve the minutes of Jan. 24, 2012. The motion passed unanimously.

S.B. 15 Off-highway Vehicles Amendments (*Sen. R. Okerlund*) (Rep. J. Draxler**)**

Sen. Okerlund introduced the bill to the committee with the assistance of Chris Haller, Utah State Parks.

Rep. Dee introduced 1st Sub. SB15.

MOTION: Rep. Dee moved to adopt 1st Sub. SB15. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Sagers absent.

Spoke for the substitution: Col. Daniel Fuhr, Utah Highway Patrol

Spoke against the bill: Mr. Michael Swenson, USA-ALL

MOTION: Rep. Mathis moved to hold SB15. The motion passed with Rep. Dee, Rep. Draxler, and Rep. Hendrickson voting in opposition. Rep. Sagers was absent for the vote.

H.B. 86 Posting of Trespass (Rep. J. Mathis)

Rep. Mathis introduced the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Mathis moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 13:

13 This bill:

► modifies the definition of "properly posted";

2. Page 2, Lines 43 through 46:

43 (d) "Properly posted" means that {~~"No Trespassing"~~} signs prohibiting
trespass or {~~a minimum of 100 square~~
44 ~~inches of~~} bright yellow, bright orange, or fluorescent paint are clearly
displayed :

(i) at all corners, fishing
45 streams crossing property lines, roads, gates, and rights-of-way entering the land {~~. If~~
metal
46 ~~fence posts are used, the entire exterior side shall be painted.~~} ; or
(ii) in a manner that would reasonably be expected to be seen by a person in the
area.

3. Page 3, Lines 59 through 65:

59 (B) the owner's employee; or
60 (C) a person with apparent authority to act for the owner; or
61 (ii) the land is fenced or otherwise enclosed in a manner that a reasonable person
62 would recognize as intended to exclude intruders {~~; or~~
63 ~~—(iii) signs or markers are posted on the land that;~~
64 ~~—(A) indicate a property boundary or prohibit entry; and~~
