## H.B. 78 Utah Division of Consumer Protection Amendments (Rep. D. Brown)

Rep. Brown introduced the bill, assisted by Traci Gundersen, Utah Department of Commerce.

(b) a fee for settling a debt may be collected only as the debt is settled.
