HEALTH INSURANCE FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS

Representative **Jim Bird** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 17:*

17 ▶ requires local school boards and charter schools to seek competitive bids on the health insurance

2. *Page 2, Line 43:*

43 (iii) a third party administrator as defined in Section 31A-1-301. =
(c) "Local school board" includes a charter school governing board.

3. *Page 2, Line 47:*

47 (3) (a) ~~{A}~~ Except as provided in Subsection (3)(c), a local school board that provides health care benefits to its employees, or a

4. *Page 2, Line 54:*

54 Subsection (4). =
(c) If a local school board issued a request for proposal for health care benefits for its employees for the 2011-12 school year, the local school board is not required to issue a request for proposal under Subsection (3)(a) until the 2013-14 school year. The local school district may, at its discretion, issue a request for proposal under Subsection (3)(a) sooner than the 2013-14 school year.

5. *Page 2, Line 57 through Page 3, Line 61:*

57 (b) retain the services of at least two producers who ~~{are}~~ ;
58 (i) are each licensed under Title 31A, Chapter 23a, Insurance Marketing - Licensing
59 Producers, Consultants, and Reinsurance Intermediaries; ~~{and}~~
60 (ii) are not affiliated with the same agency license issued under Title 31A, Chapter 23a,
61 Insurance Marketing - Licensing Producers, Consultants, and Reinsurance Intermediaries ; and
(iii) do not collect a fee from the school board unless the school board selects the health insurance plan submitted by the producer .
