  - (ii) when fraud or other intentional and willful misrepresentation is alleged and the pharmacy audit entity has evidence that the pharmacy's actions reasonably indicate fraud .
- 3. Page 15, Line 449:
- 449 { <u>in the absence of any other evidence deemed fraudulent</u>} <u>unless the entity has evidence the actions by</u>
  the pharmacy constituted fraud ; or
- 4. Page 16, Lines 480 through 482:
  - 480 { (10) This section does not apply to any audit, review, or investigation that involves
  - 481 <u>probable Medicaid fraud, probable Medicaid abuse, probable insurance fraud, or other criminal</u>
  - 482 <u>fraud or criminal misrepresentation</u>} <u>.</u>
