Senator Mark B. Madsen proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 16:
  - This bill:
  - allows a law enforcement officer currently employed and in good standing to
  - purchase a firearm without paying the requisite background check fee as long as the
  - dealer verifies the officer's employment and standing with the employing agency : and
    - <u>requires a dealer who provides a firearm to a law enforcement officer to use the NCIS system to run the background check</u>.
- 2. Page 4, Lines 105 through 108 House Committee Amendments 2-6-2012:
  - 105 (14) (a) A law enforcement officer, as defined in Section 53-13-103, is exempt from the
  - background check fee required in this section for the purchase of a firearm if  $\hat{H} \rightarrow [$ the dealer verifies
  - with the employing agency that  $\leftarrow \hat{H}$  the law enforcement officer  $\hat{H} \rightarrow \text{verifies current}$
  - 107a employment by providing a letter of good standing from the officer's commanding officer and
  - 107b <u>current law enforcement photo identification</u>. [is currently employed and in good
  - 108 standing as of the date of purchase.] ←Ĥ
    - (b) A dealer who provides a firearm to a law enforcement officer under this Subsection shall use the National Instant Criminal Background Check System to run the background check required by the Brady Handgun Violence Prevention Act, Pub. L. No. 103-159, 107 Stat. 1536 (1993).
