- 2. Page 4, Line 88:
  - (u) adopting other traffic ordinances as specifically authorized by this chapter : or

    (v) adopting an ordinance that requires a ground transportation vehicle to conform to annual appearance inspection requirements.
- 3. Page 4, Lines 97b through 97c House Floor Amendments 2-24-2012:
  - 97b (ii) provides that a person must be issued at least three warning citations { within a
  - 97c <u>one-year period</u>} <u>before imposing a fine;</u>
- 4. Page 4, Lines 97e through 97j a.House Floor Amendments b.2-24-2012:
  - 97e (iv) provides for the safety of law enforcement personnel who enforce the
  - 97f <u>ordinance;</u> { and }
    - (v) provides that an owner or operator of a vehicle may lawfully cause or permit the vehicle's engine to idle continuously for at least three minutes; and
  - 97g { (v) | vi) provides that the ordinance may { only } be enforced :

    (A) on private property or on a
  - 97h quasi-public road or parking area as defined in Section 41-6a-214 if the owner of the private
  - 97i property requests, through written or electronic means, that the ordinance be enforced on the
  - 97j <u>private property; or</u>
    - (B) on private property that has a private business with a drive-through service as a component of

the private business operations unless the private property owner posts one sign provided at no cost by
the local highway authority or acceptable to the local highway authority informing its customers and the
public of the local highway authority's policy regarding idling vehicle engines; or
