Representative **Val L. Peterson** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 13 through 19*

*House Committee Amendments*

- 13           ▶       provides that the Driver License Division may not license a person who is

14   of age or older and who has not completed an approved course in driver training unless the person:

                  permit for three months before applying for an original class D license; and

17   Driver License Division, has completed at least 40 hours of driving a motor

- 39           (iii) if the person is ~~H~~→ [+8] 19 ←~~H~~ years of age or older ; has not completed:  
40           (A) a course in driver training approved by the commissioner; or  
41           (B) the {driving requirement} requirements under Subsection 53-3-210.5(6)(c);

- 320           (c) An applicant is exempt from the requirement under Subsection (6)(a)(i) if the  
321   applicant:

                  = (ii) holds a learner permit for three months before applying for an original class D license; and  
323           ~~{(ii)}~~ (iii) certifies that the applicant, under the authority of a permit issued under this chapter,  
324   has completed at least 40 hours of driving a motor vehicle, of which at least 10 hours were  
325   completed during night hours after sunset.
