

JOINT RESOLUTION ON ENGAGEMENT IN PUBLIC EDUCATION SYSTEM

Senator **Mark B. Madsen** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 13 through 14:*

13 ▶ expresses a legislative desire to improve collaboration between the Legislature ~~{-and}~~ ;
14 the State Board of Education , and teachers in the public schools of the state ;

2. *Page 1, Line 17:*

17 seven days; ~~{-and}~~
▶ encourages public education teachers to read an online fact sheet and take a test on information contained in the fact sheet;

3. *Page 1, Line 20:*

20 visits and where the fact sheet and test results can be maintained .

4. *Page 1, Line 26:*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature encourages teachers in the public schools of the state to participate, on a rotating basis at the rate of about 2% per month, in an online activity consisting of reading a fact sheet relating to commonly misunderstood aspects of public education, developed by or under the direction of the Legislative Management Committee, and then answering a set of questions testing knowledge gained from information in that fact sheet.

9. *Page 2, Line 48:*

48 the public an opportunity to read and review that information , and where the public can view the fact sheet developed by or under the direction of the Legislative Management Committee and the results of the test that teachers take relating to the information on the fact sheet may be maintained and made available to the public .
