26	(1) Both the husband and wife, or either of them separately, are responsible for the
27	expenses of the family and the education of the children, and they may be sued jointly or
28	separately for the recovery of any expenses related to the family or the education of the
29	children.
30	(2) For the expenses described in Subsection (1), the creditor shall be entitled to
31	recover against the husband and wife, jointly and severally, all amounts provided for in a
32	written contract signed by either the husband or wife, or as otherwise provided by law.
33	(3) Subsection (2) applies to all contracts under this section entered into by either
34	spouse any time the parties are married and living together as husband and wife.
