30-1-16, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section 30-1-16 is amended to read:

30-1-16. Misconduct of county clerk -- Penalty.

Every clerk or deputy clerk who knowingly issues a license for any prohibited marriage [shall be punished by confinement in the state prison for a term not exceeding two years, or by fine in any sum not exceeding \$1,000, or by both such fine and imprisonment, and upon
