COLLEGE CREDITS FOR VETERANS

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
Section 1. Section 53B-16-107 is enacted to read:
53B-16-107. Credit for military service and training Transferability
Reporting.
(1) As used in this section, "credit" includes proof of equivalent noncredit course
completion awarded by the Utah College of Applied Technology.
(2) An institution of higher education listed in Section 53B-2-101 shall award credit for
military service and training as recommended by a postsecondary accreditation agency or
association designated by the State Board of Regents if:
(a) requested by the student; and
(b) the student has met with an advisor at an institution of higher education listed in
Section 53B-1-101 at which the student intends to enroll to discuss applicability of credit to
program requirements, possible financial aid implications, and other factors that may impact
attainment of the student's educational goals.
(3) Upon transfer within the state system of higher education, a student may present a
transcript to the receiving institution for evaluation and to determine the applicability of credit
to the student's program of study, and the receiving institution shall evaluate the credit to be
transferred pursuant to Subsection (2).
(4) The State Board of Regents and the Utah College of Applied Technology Board of
Trustees shall annually report the number of credits awarded under this section by each
institution of higher education to the Education Interim Committee and the Utah Department of
Veterans' Affairs.
