General Description:
This rules resolution modifies joint rules that relate to the requirements for passage of
legislation.
Highlighted Provisions:
This resolution:
<ul> <li>prohibits a house of the Legislature from passing legislation unless the legislation</li> </ul>
has been numbered and publicly available for at least 72 hours;
provides that the 72-hour requirement does not apply to:
<ul> <li>amendments to and substitutes to legislation;</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>appropriations bills; or</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>legislation being considered during the last three days of the annual general</li> </ul>
session; and
<ul> <li>permits the notice requirement to be waived by a two-thirds constitutional majority,</li> </ul>
provided that the motion is made:
<ul> <li>separately from a vote to pass the legislation or any other motion; and</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>in relation to only the bill or resolution being considered.</li> </ul>

(3) (a) The House may suspend this rule only by a constitutional two-thirds vote. 41 42 (b) A motion to suspend this rule may not be combined with another motion and shall affect only a single bill or resolution. 43
