General Description:

This bill amends the Medical Assistance Act of the Health Code.

26-28-17, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **26-28-17** is enacted to read:

26-28-17. Medicaid vision services -- Request for proposals.

The department may select a contractor in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 6, Utah Procurement Code, to provide vision services to all Medicaid populations within existing appropriations from the Legislature.
