LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies the Traffic Code by enacting provisions relating to runaway vehicle ramps.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ prohibits a person from using a runaway vehicle ramp unless the person is in an emergency situation requiring use of the ramp to stop the person's vehicle; and
- ▶ prohibits a person from stopping, standing, or parking on a runaway vehicle ramp or in the pathway of a runaway vehicle ramp.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **41-6a-717** is enacted to read:

41-6a-717. Use of runaway vehicle ramps.



28 (1) A person may not use a runaway vehicle ramp unless the person is in an emergency
29 situation requiring the use of the ramp to stop the person's vehicle.

30 (2) A person may not stop, stand, or park a vehicle on a runaway vehicle ramp or in the
31 pathway of the runaway vehicle ramp.
