29	(1) There is created the Education Task Force consisting of the following 14 members:
30	(a) the president of the Senate;
31	(b) the Senate chair of each of the following committees:
32	(i) the Higher Education Appropriations Subcommittee;
33	(ii) the Public Education Appropriations Subcommittee; and
34	(iii) the Senate Education Committee;
35	(c) the Senate minority leader;
36	(d) one member of the Senate appointed by the president of the Senate;

39	(g) the House chair of each of the following committees:

62	(b) alignment of public education and higher education, including the Utah College of
63	Applied Technology, within their individual organizational structures and a combined seamless
64	alignment of public education and higher education in support of a successful education system
65	for student achievement;
66	(c) alignment of both public education and higher education with the state's economic
67	development goals and workforce needs;
68	(d) long-term priorities for public education and higher education funding and
69	budgeting; and
70	(e) setting standards to be economically competitive in the United States and
71	throughout the world.
72	(2) A final report, including any proposed legislation, shall be presented to both the
73	Education Interim Committee and the Executive Appropriations Committee before December
74	<u>31, 2013.</u>
75	Section 3. Appropriation.
76	Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures Act, for
77	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, the following sums of money
78	are appropriated from resources not otherwise appropriated, or reduced from amounts
79	previously appropriated, out of the funds or accounts indicated. These sums of money are in
80	addition to any amounts previously appropriated for fiscal year 2014.
