The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 149**, AMENDMENTS TO UTAH EXEMPTIONS ACT, by Representative E. Tanner, with the following amendments:

1. Page 2, Lines 52 through 53

- 52 (ii) [\$20,000] $\hat{H} \rightarrow \{+\}$ \$30,000 $\{+\}$ $\{-\$40,000\}$ $\leftarrow \hat{H}$ in value if the property claimed is the primary
- 52a personal
- residence of the individual.
- 2. Page 3, Lines 58 through 59

- 58 (ii) for property exempt under Subsection (2)(a)(ii), the maximum exemption may not
