NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO THE RULES COMMITTEE

March 8, 2013

Mr. President:

The Economic Development and Workforce Services Committee has returned **S.B. 46**, OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH AMENDMENTS, by Senator L. Robles, to the Rules Committee without recommendation but with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 16:
 - 15 reates the Occupational Safety and Health Restricted Account; {-and-}
 - requires reporting; and
 - 16 makes technical and conforming amendments.
- 2. Page 8, Lines 231 through 233:
 - 231 (3) Subject to appropriation by the Legislature, the division shall use the money in the
 - 232 Occupational Safety and Health Restricted Account to :
 - (a) fund the program of investigations
 - established under Subsection 34A-6-301(1)(b) : and
 (b) with the money remaining in the Occupational Safety and Health Restricted
 Account after funding the program described in Subsection (3)(a), fund activities of the division that are authorized under this chapter and address occupational health and safety.
 - (4) The division shall annually report to the Business, Economic Development, and Labor Appropriations Subcommittee regarding the programs and services funded by the Occupational Safety and Health Restricted Account.
