Mr. President:

The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 218**, RECEIVING CENTERS FUNDING AMENDMENTS, by Senator D. Thatcher, with the following amendments and recommends it be considered read for the second time and placed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 16:
 - states that funding for receiving centers <u>and youth services programs</u> is intended to include federal grant money,
 - local government money, and private donations {; and }

 - 15 each public agency designated to oversee the receiving center and cover
 - 16 administrative costs.
- 2. Page 2, Line 28:
 - 28 {-(1)--} Funding for receiving centers and youth services programs under this part is intended to be broad based, be
- *3. Page 2, Lines 31 through 33:*
 - 31 {<u>(2) The money appropriated shall be used to contract with each public</u> agency
