1. Page 5, Lines 132 through 135:

132 [~~(14)~~] (15) If the individual is incarcerated, the incarcerating authority shall either

133 the blood specimen or shall pay the expenses of having the individual's blood drawn.

134 {~~(16) The results of testing performed under this section are not admissible in~~
~~any civil~~

135 ~~or criminal proceeding.~~}
