Sen. Dayton announced that H.B. 325 would not be heard.

#### **Approval of Minutes**

**MOTION:** Sen. Van Tassell moved to approve the minutes of the March 4, 2013 meeting. The motion passed unanimously with Sens. Robles and Shiozawa absent for the vote.

#### S.B. 278 Capital Improvement Amendments (Sen. W. Harper)

Sen. Harper introduced and explained the bill.

Spoke to the bill: Mr. David Buhler, Commissioner, Utah System of Higher Education

**MOTION:** Sen. Van Tassell moved to pass S.B. 278 out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Sens. Robles and Shiozawa absent for the vote.

#### S.B. 246 Volunteer Workers Amendments (Sen. S. Jenkins)

Sen. Jenkins introduced and explained the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Robles moved to amend S.B. 246 as follows:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 44 through 49:
  - 44 [Any] (1) A person performing services on a voluntary basis, without compensation,
  - under the general supervision of, and on behalf of any public entity, [shall be] is immune

from

- 46 liability with respect to any decisions or actions, other than in connection with the operation of
- 47 a motor vehicle, taken during the course of those services, unless it is established that  $\{+\}$  such
- 48 decisions or actions were grossly negligent, not made in good faith, or were made maliciously {+}
- 49 {<u>the volunteer willfully and knowingly caused harm to a person or property</u>}.

The motion failed, with Sens. Robles and Thatcher voting in favor.

**SUBSTITUTE MOTION:** Sen. Thatcher moved to amend S.B. 246 as follows:

Page 2, Line 49: After "knowingly" insert "or recklessly"

The motion failed with Sens. Dayton, Robles, Shiozawa and Van Tassell voting in opposition.

The original motion passed unanimously.

# S.B. 265 Referendum Amendments (Sen. J. Valentine)

Sen. Valentine introduced and explained the bill.
