1. *Page 1, Line 26:*

26 This bill takes effect on July 1, 2013.

Section 8. Coordinating H.B. 223 with H.B. 302 -- Substantive and technical amendments.

If this H.B. 223 and H.B. 302, Emergency Response Amendments, both pass and become law, it is the intent of the Legislature that:

(1) Subsection 53-2-404(1) shall be amended to read:

"(1) Subject to this section and Section ~~[53-2-403]~~ 53-2a-603, the division ~~[shall expend or commit to expend money described in Subsection 53-2-403(1)(d)(i) to fund costs to the state of emergency disaster services]~~ may expend or commit to expend money described in Subsection 53-2a-603(2)(a)(i), (ii), or (iii) to fund costs to the state of emergency disaster services if, at the discretion of the division, the expenditure is necessary in response to the disaster." ;

(2) Subsection 63J-1-602.3(2) shall be amended to read:

"(2) Appropriations made to the Division of Emergency Management from the State Disaster Recovery Restricted Account, as provided in Section 53-2a-603. "; and

(3) the Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel make these changes when preparing

the Utah Code database for publication.
