LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill requires the Governor's Office of Economic Development to hold a meeting on daylight saving time.

- ▶ requires the Governor's Office of Economic Development to report on the meeting to the Government Operations Interim Committee ~~H→~~ **and the Economic Development and**

Workforce Services Interim Committee ←~~H~~ .
