35 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

36 Section 1. Section **53A-1-710** is enacted to read:

37 **53A-1-710. Grants for digital textbooks.**

38 (1) (a) The State Board of Education shall award grants to a school district or charter
39 school to facilitate the adoption of digital textbooks.

40 (b) A school district or charter school that receives a grant described in Subsection

41 (1)(a) may use the grant to purchase:

42 (i) digital textbooks;

43 (ii) personal mobile devices; and

44 (iii) desktop or laptop computers.

45 (2) (a) The State Board of Education shall solicit proposals from school districts and
46 charter schools for the use of the grant to facilitate the adoption of digital textbooks.

47 (b) In awarding a grant under Subsection (1), the State Board of Education shall
48 consider the applicant's capacity to use the grant to serve the greatest number of students
49 possible.

50 (3) A grant awarded under Subsection (1) may not:

51 (a) exceed \$500 per student; or

52 (b) be used for:

53 (i) peripherals or networking equipment, including a wireless network; or

54 (ii) professional development for educators.

55 (4) (a) The State Board of Education shall annually report to the Legislature's Public
56 Education Appropriations Subcommittee on the following:

57 (i) the subject area of the classes that converted to digital textbooks;

58 (ii) the cost per student for the conversion to digital textbooks; and

59 (iii) student and teacher satisfaction with digital textbooks.

60 (b) A school district or charter school that receives a grant described in Subsection (1)
61 shall provide to the State Board of Education information that is necessary for the board's
62 report to the Legislature's Public Education Appropriations Subcommittee as required in
63 Subsection (4)(a).

77 Section 3. **Appropriation.**

78 Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures Act, for
79 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, and ending June 30, 2015, the following sums of money
80 are appropriated from resources not otherwise appropriated, or reduced from amounts
81 previously appropriated, out of the funds or accounts indicated. These sums of money are in
82 addition to any amounts previously appropriated for fiscal year 2015.
