30 (a) "Qualified long-term care insurance contract" is as defined in 26 U.S.C. Sec. 31 7702B(b). (b) "Qualified long-term care insurance partnership" is as defined in 42 U.S.C. Sec. 32 33 1396p(b)(iii). 34 (c) "State plan amendment" means an amendment to the state Medicaid plan drafted by 35 the department in compliance with this section. (2) No later than July 1, 2014, the department shall seek federal approval of a state plan 36 amendment that creates a qualified long-term care insurance partnership. 37 (3) The department may make rules to comply with federal laws and regulations 38 39 relating to qualified long-term care insurance partnerships and qualified long-term care

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insurance contracts.

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
